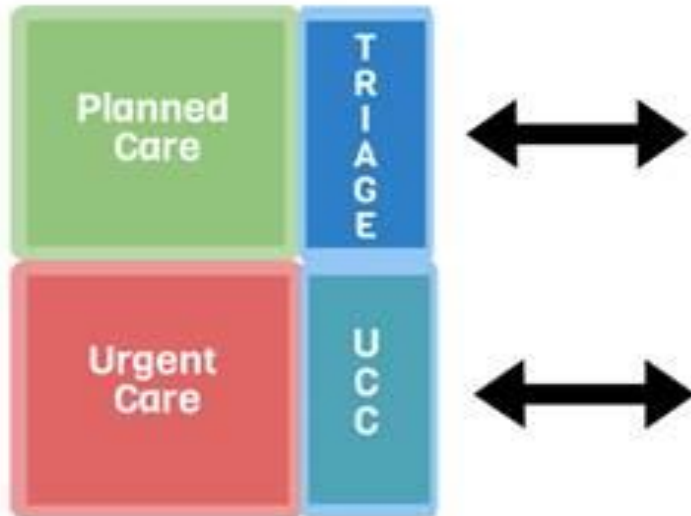

Commissioning Shared Outcomes



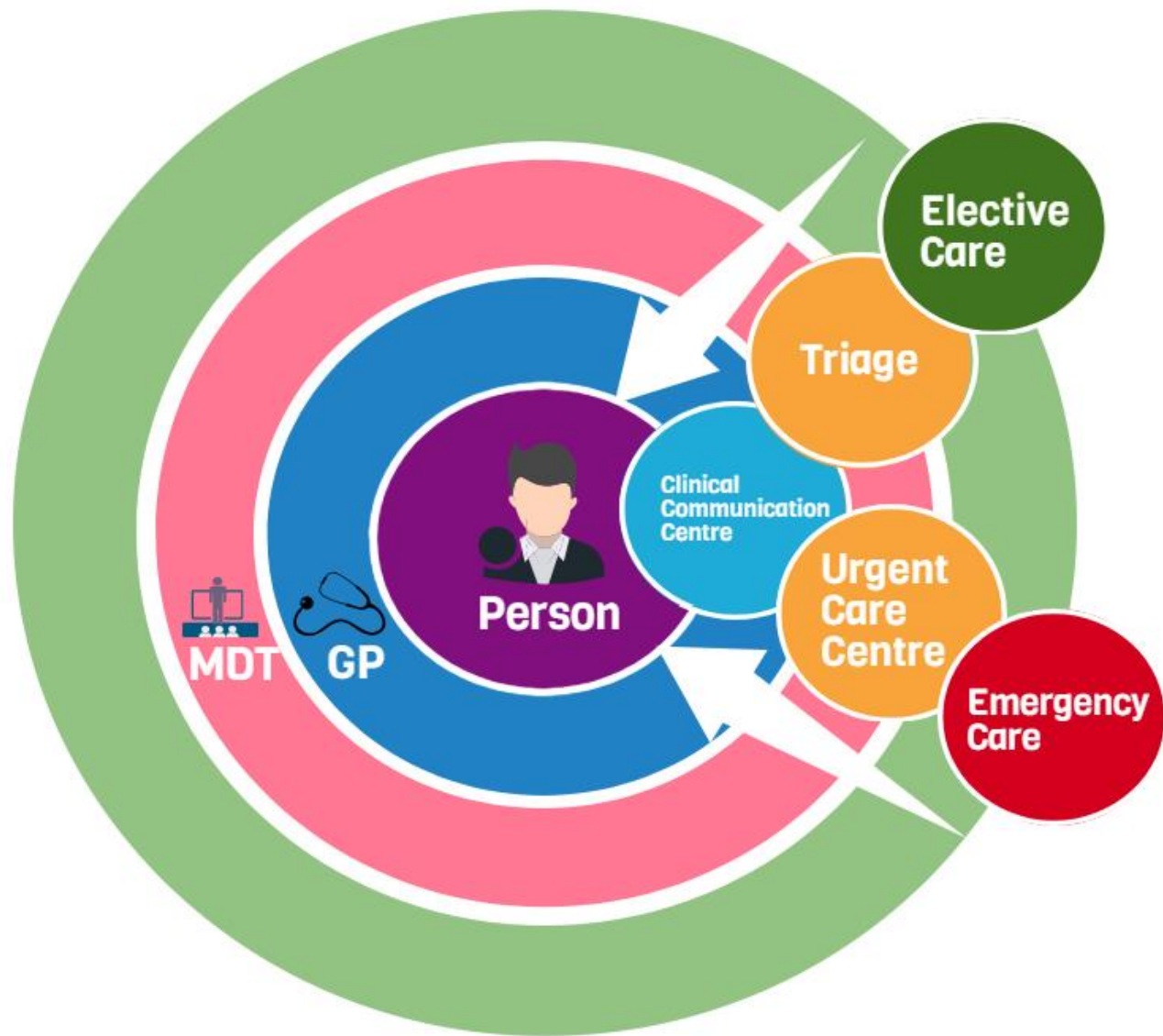
Our model is based on the following principles:

Maximising the potential of:

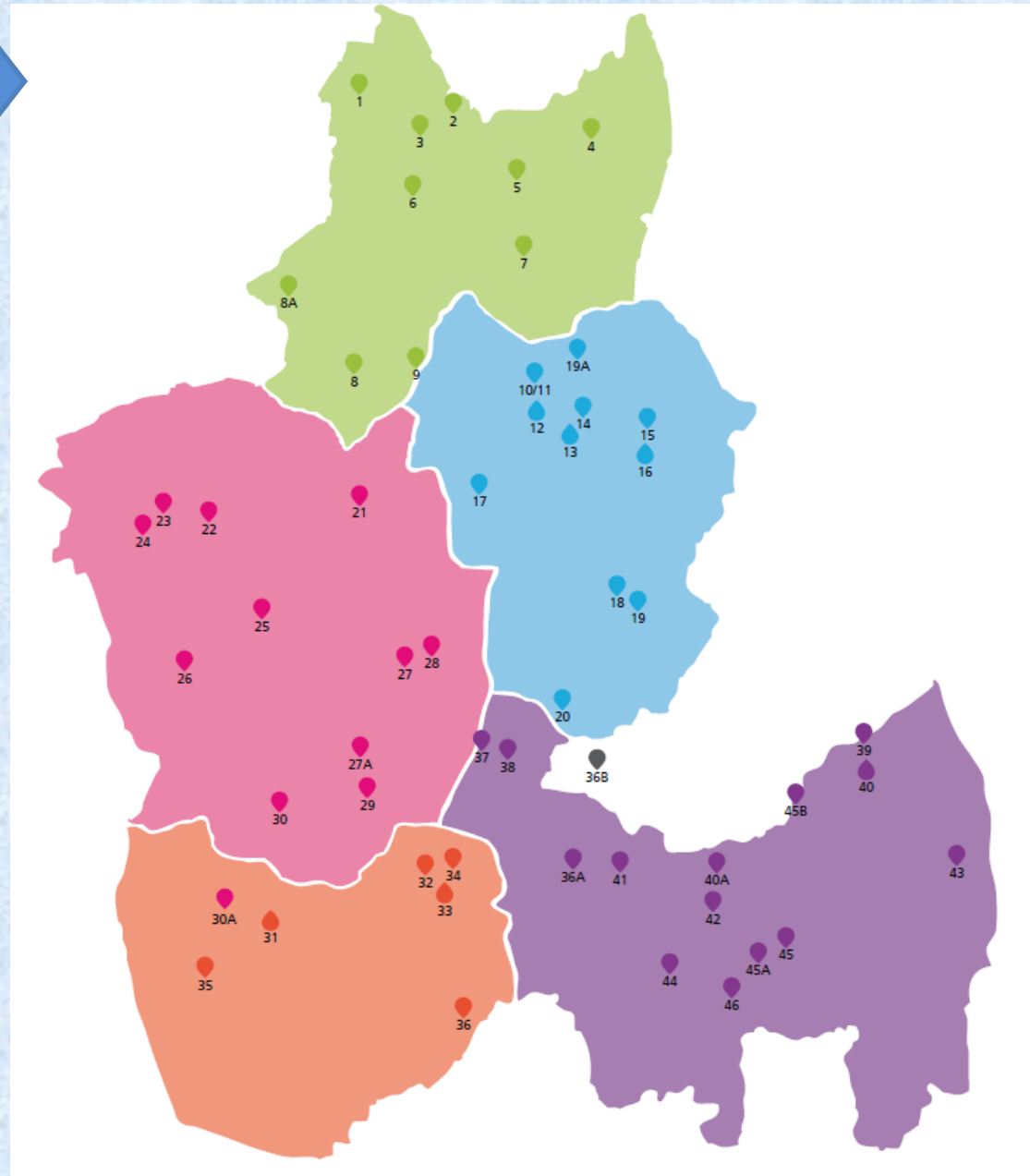
- The individual (in their community)

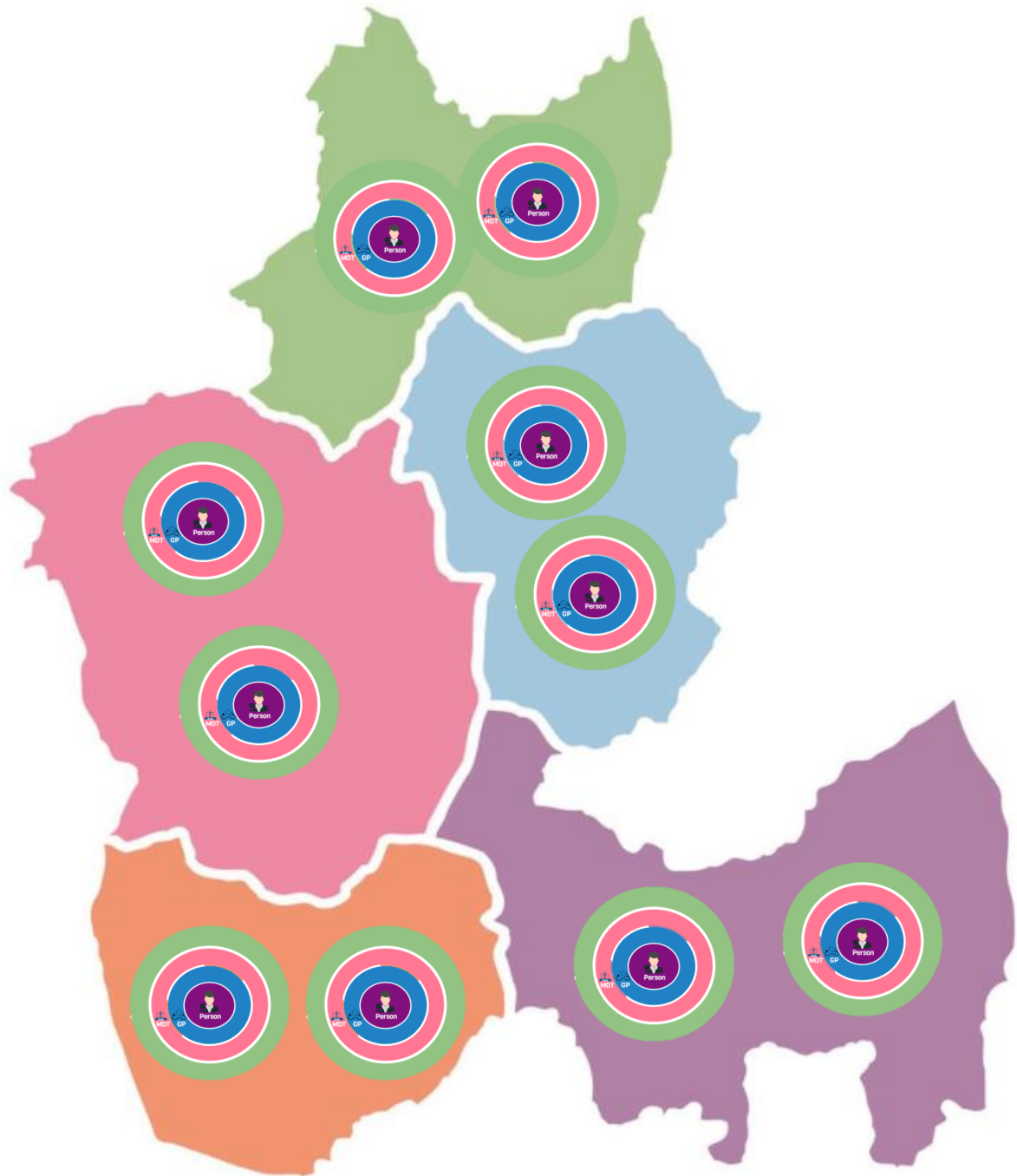

- 45 GP practices
- 1 main Acute Provider (80% patient flow)
- CCG Coterminous with the Metropolitan Borough Council
- 315,000 registered population

# The Scope of the MCP

- community based physical health services for adults and children;
- out-patient services for adults and children;
- urgent care centre and primary care out of hours service;
- primary medical services provided under existing GMS/PMS/APMS contracts;
- all mental health and learning disability services;
- intermediate care services and NHS Continuing Healthcare
- end of life services;
- voluntary and community sector services;
- services commissioned by Dudley MBC's Office of Public Health including health visiting, family nurse partnership, substance misuse and sexual health services;
- adult social care services (to be phased in).
- some CCG activities



# The MCP Clinical Model

- Diabetes
- Respiratory
- MSK triage
- Services for children aged 0-19
- Community Nursing
- New MDT
- Dermatology
- Children – the acutely unwell child
- Mental Health
- Substance Misuse
- Communications Centre
- New Technology

# The Principles of the MCP....

- The MCP will be an NHS provider of integrated primary and community services.
- It is being formed as a result of historical silos between primary, community, mental health, social care and acute services.
- The building blocks of an MCP are the integrated teams working at approximately 30,000 patient population
- Increased public accountability
- Better outcomes for patients
- Digital transformation – shared clinical records
- A prevention/early intervention emphasis

# How will it be different?

- the contract will be based upon a single, whole population budget for a duration of 15 years;
- a single legal entity (one contract between CCG and MCP)
- the MCP will be an outcomes based contract with performance related payments;
- Primary care, community, mental health, social care and voluntary care services will be integrated;
- some out-patient services, traditionally provided by secondary care, (such as diabetes and respiratory) will be delivered by the MCP;
- primary care, delivered by general practice, will be at the heart of the organisation
- a new contractual framework for enhanced primary care services (the Dudley Outcomes for Health Framework).

# What type of an organisation will the MCP be?

- An NHS organisation
- Values based and driven
- An employer of choice
- Patient care at the heart of decision making
- Clinically led
- GP registered lists based services
- MDTs at the heart
- An active and positive player in the local system
